A packet of information should be prepared for each nominee, containing:

- a) two or more letters of nomination discussing the nominee's qualities, contributions, and achievements;
- b) a curriculum vitae descriptive of the nominee's qualities and achievements, (including those related to instruction) and containing the student's social security number, a phone number, home town and state, and an address where the student can be easily reached during the semester; and
- c) a short biographical sketch suitable for reading at one or both awards ceremonies (should the student be selected).

Also, please note that the honoree must be a documented resident of the United States in order for the IRS to allow us to pay for the award.

To be considered, containing the materials and information indicated above must be submitted to the Dean's Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 12, 2011.
